Dear RCSD Parents and Guardians:

A number of children in the Rye City School District have allergies to peanuts/tree nuts. Should one of these students ingest, touch or inhale these nuts, a severe life-threatening reaction may follow. While there are students with different types of allergies, evidence suggests that students in this age group with peanut/nut tree allergies are most at risk. Please be aware that:

- Nut allergies require stringent avoidance and management plans because it is one of the most common food allergies in children, adolescents and adults
- Reactions to nuts are often more severe than to other foods and are a leading cause of severe, life-threatening, and even fatal allergic reactions
- Cross contamination is most likely to occur with peanut butter due to the adhesive nature of the peanut protein to other foods/surfaces

I encourage you to join us in ensuring a safe environment for all our children. To do this we need the support and cooperation of the entire District. We respectfully request students bring lunches and snacks free of peanuts and tree nuts. We are also asking parents/guardians to read food labels and check for peanut/tree nut ingredients prior to sending food to school.

If you have caregivers who provide your child(ren) with lunches or snacks, we ask that you share this letter with them. Rye City School District acknowledges that it is not possible to guarantee an environment completely free of potential hazards; however, compliance to reasonable guidelines and requests will minimize potential risks.

We trust that you understand how deeply important it is to respect and adhere to these guidelines. We realize this request may require added planning and effort on your part when packing your child's lunch and snacks and we wish to express our sincere appreciation in advance for your support and cooperation.
